- Complete application in Major Clarity (application will be opened beginning February 1st for summer/following school year)
- If you arrange your own internship, fill in details and contact information on the application
- For medical internships, submit vaccination records
- Interview with prospective sponsor (if necessary)
- **Deadlines**: April 15 for a summer internship, May 1 for a first semester internship the following school year and October 1 for a second semester internship.
